Lime Tuff is extremely hardy and can tolerate frost, drought, shade, sun and coastal conditions, as well as clay or sandy soils. Because of its shape and size, Lime Tuff is ideal to use for contrast, low level plantings where height restrictions are required in urban landscapes. It can also be used to create borders or for understory plantings in the home garden.

Lime Tuff is recognized for its vibrant colour and hardy nature. Its low maintenance and high health characteristics result in it being one of the toughest Lomandra in the market.
