It's a quick growing, drought and frost tolerant variety that is long lived and retains its dark green colour year round. Assisting with weed suppression, erosion control and revegetation, Verday is an excellent choice for a wide range of landscape applications. This includes roadside plantings, playgrounds and parks and formal gardens.

Verday produces pale yellow, perfumed flowers in spring and summer, and is highly tolerant of air pollution, heat from pavements and buildings, and requires little to no maintenance and irrigation.

COMMON NAME	Spiny-headed mat-rush

KEY NOTES/ATTRIBUTES	Narrow leaves, uniform shape.

HABIT	Semi-upright/weeping, dense foliage. Slightly pendulous.
MAINTENANCE	Low maintenance, may need a cut back every 3-4 years
SEASONAL CLIMATE ZONE	Zones 1 to 4
RECOMMENDED POT/PLUG RATIO	1 plug per 140mm pot
FLOWERING PERIOD	Early spring, spot flowering in autumn.
GROWING MEDIA PH RANGE	6-6.5 pH
WATERING	Provide even watering for consistent growth. Reduce watering during cooler periods.
FERTILISER	A good quality, native plant fertiliser is best. Supplement with liquid feeds if necessary.
PESTS & DISEASES	No major pest or disease issues, however, dieback can be caused by over-watering, especially during cooler periods.
FINISHING TIMES	in 140mm pot, 10-12 weeks
LIGHT REQUIREMENT	Full sun/part shade
