TECHNICAL DATA**Hibiscus *Klahanie***

GENUS/SPECIES	<i>hibiscus rosa sinensis</i>
VARIETY	Klahanie
COMMON NAME	Hawaiian Hibiscus
PRODUCED FROM	Cuttings
KEY NOTES/ATTRIBUTES	Hardy, compact, medium sized shrub with large, long-lasting blooms on mid-green foliage.
HEIGHT	1m
WIDTH	1m
HABIT	Compact, well-branched habit.
MAINTENANCE	Plugs should be planted as soon as possible once delivered. Do not allow plugs to dry out.
SEASONAL CLIMATE ZONE	Zones 1 to 3
RECOMMENDED POT/PLUG RATIO	1 plug per 140mm or 200mm pot
FLOWERING PERIOD	Early spring through to autumn
GROWING MEDIA PH RANGE	pH 6.0-6.5
WATERING	Keep media evenly moist. Do not allow to dry out, and avoid 'wet' feet as they do not like it.
FERTILISER	Hibiscus need to be well fertilised and respond well to a citrus or specialised hibiscus food.
PESTS & DISEASES	Two spotted mites, whitefly, hibiscus beetle and metallic flea beetle. Check frequently and water thoroughly before using insecticides to lessen the shock. Fungal problems include fly spec on leaves, or collar rot. Avoid mulching close to stem to prevent collar rot.
FINISHING TIMES	In 140mm pot, 12-14 weeks.
LIGHT REQUIREMENT	Full sun but protect from harsh afternoon sun in summer.

Notes:

Varieties in the Klahanie range:

- **Coconut Ice** - Blush pink with a deep red eye.
- **Wild Cherry** - hot pink with ruffled petals
- **Golden Dreams** - Sunset orange, doubled flowers
- **Tropicana** - Bright pink and light yellow bi-colour
