







## Lomandra confertifolia 'SIR5' (D) Wingarra $^{(1)}$

Lomandra Wingarra has been performing in tough Australian landscapes for over a decade. This is due to its unique deep rhizomes that are unseen in other confertifolia varieties, making it tougher than the rest.

Wingarra has fine blue-green foliage that contrasts with small yellow flowers, creating beautiful texture in the garden. Ideal for borders and mass planting, this Lomandra is extremely low maintenance.
