

SENECIO SERPENS DWARF BLUE CHALK STICKS

SPECIES: *Senecio serpens* **COMMON NAME:** Dwarf Blue Chalk Sticks

Senecio serpens Dwarf Blue Chalk Sticks is an attractive/compact prostrate ground cover, which branches from the base. A smaller variety of *Senecio* Chalk Sticks. It creates a spreading dense mat of cover, is drought and frost tolerant and is perfect for coastal gardens as it can tolerate salt wind winds.

Dwarf Blue Chalk Sticks offer cylindrical silvery-blue foliage and will produce creamy yellow flowers in mid Summer to early Autumn. This *senecio* creates a brilliant sea of blue when massed in a landscape garden.

CARE:

Plant in any soil type, clay, sand, or well drained. Use a quality cacti and succulent potting mix if planting in a container/pot. Remove damaged or yellowing leaves as they occur. Allow soil to dry out between watering's, do not sit in saucers of water.
