Dwarf Blue Chalk Sticks offer cylindrical silvery-blue foliage and will produce creamy yellow flowers in mid Summer to early Autumn. This senecio creates a brilliant sea of blue when massed in a landscape garden.

CARE:

Plant in any soil type, clay, sand, or well drained. Use a quality cacti and succulent potting mix if planting in a container/pot. Remove damaged or yellowing leaves as they occur. Allow soil to dry out between watering's, do not sit in saucers of water.
